

Attention all CNTL members.

Please be advised that Council 4000 will be hosting information sessions via Zoom on **Saturday**, **April 6**, and **Sunday**, **April 7**, specifically to discuss the CNTL strike voting. These sessions are of utmost importance, and we urge all members to participate. To join, please follow the links below, which will lead you to a registration page. Registration is open until the end of each meeting, and it's mandatory to register before joining the Zoom meeting.

A strike vote will take place on Monday, April 8, via Simply Voting. This vote is part of the conciliation process set out in the Canada Labour Code, and the membership needs to vote in favour of strike action as a strong strike mandate shows CNTL management that you support your bargaining committee. Voting 'yes' does not mean we are going on strike, but you would support such action if CNTL scaled back what we already negotiated.
